Hong Kong

Relocation of the Shatin Sewage Treatment Works

- Event co-hosted with China State Construction
- Land Development: Supported Hong Kong's sustainable development by relocating Shatin Sewage Treatment Works to free up 28 hectares for housing and other uses.
- Site Development: Successfully contracted the project for site development and construction of a connection tunnel.
- Ongoing road construction and foundation works for a temporary flyover.
- Advanced Technology Adoption: Implemented BIM, 4D immersive environments, and GIS for project monitoring. Used virtual simulations for safety training, enhancing worker safety awareness.



Abu Dhabi

Jubail Mangrove Park, highlighting sustainable design

- A Tomorrow's Leaders event, with the objective of changing the image of construction for future project managers.
- Understanding Sustainable methods of construction in protected areas. Special techniques in construction design and planning
- Learnt about the relationship between environment agency and contractor
- Understanding the importance of the mangrove tree in particular carbon sequestration and storage and how it can support the built environment



Melbourne

ANZAC Station

- Hosted by Metro Tunnel
- Tour of newly completed station
- Viewing the design features that will provide a enjoyable experience to the users of the built environment
- Anzac Station has been designed as a ‘pavilion in the park’ – an integrated public building and landmark that connects seamlessly with surrounding parklands.
- The canopy above the tram interchange is an architectural focal point, providing waiting passengers with year-round weather protection. Large skylights embedded in the canopy will fill the station concourse below with natural light.
