Who are we?

About our professional qualification, MCIQB

MCIQB is a professional qualification in the Construction Management discipline, respected by employers, governments, teaching institutes and organisations all over the world. For professionals working in education, the MCIQB qualification testifies to the currency of your specialist knowledge and skills.

To gain MCIQB through the academic route, candidates must demonstrate competence in the core occupational skills:

- Promoting industry engagement in education
- Applying current best practice to design or delivery of the curriculum
- Undertaking Continuous Professional Development in current industry practice
- Promoting ethical practice
- Promoting innovation in construction
- Promoting access to the profession

Candidates must also demonstrate competence in one specialist area.

The specialist areas include:

- Advancing Construction Management knowledge
- Advancing learning and teaching
- Leadership and management in education

Membership of the CIOB will give you a respected competence qualification, access to professional development opportunities and a voice in the industry.

How does MCIQB compare to other qualifications?

We commissioned an external review and benchmarking of MCIQB by a qualifications comparison agency, UK NARIC.

The MCIQB qualification is benchmarked at Level 6 with some elements of Level 7 on the UK Qualifications Credit Framework (QCF). The QCF is a UK framework for vocational and competence based qualifications.

Who is the Academic Route for?

The MCIQB qualification through the academic route is designed to suit a range of professionals in Construction Management education or training, from those working in learning and teaching, to those working in research and managers of construction departments. Candidates may be employed in further or higher education or in a private training provider.
